It is my understanding that the new future recovery monies from the above styled cause will be paid to the Osage Shareholders (Annuitants) as the only parties interested and entitled to said recovery.

I believe that all annuitants and members of the Osage Tribe are entitled to the continuing fiduciary relationship the Department of Interior has had with us for so many years.

I want the recovery monies, which will have the same standing as my headright money, to be distributed to me by the Bureau of Indian Affairs/Office of Special Trustee, just like I receive my quarterly payment.

As a member of the Osage Nation and Shareholder and Annuitant of the mineral estate of the Tribe there are many more members of the Osage Nation who are not Shareholders and Annuitants, who are not entitled to share in said recovery.
